2. day to day responsibility for ensuring this policy is put into practice

3. to ensure health and safety standards are maintained/improved, Areas include safety, risk assessment, consultation, accidents, first-aid and workrelated ill-health, monitoring, accident and ill-health investigation, emergency procedures, fire and evacuation, maintaining equipment, information, instruction and supervision and training.

Part three: arrangements for health and safety

Risk assessment

Relevant risk assessments will be completed, and action taken

Risk assistance will be reviewed when working habits or conditions change

Training

Staff and subcontractors will have health and safety induction and be provided appropriate training

Personal protective equipment will be provided
Suitable arrangements will be in place for employees who work remotely

Consultation

Staff will be routinely briefed on health and safety matters as they arise informally when health and safety is reviewed

Evacuation

All escape routes in places of work are made known.

Evacuation plans are tested from time to time and updated if necessary.
